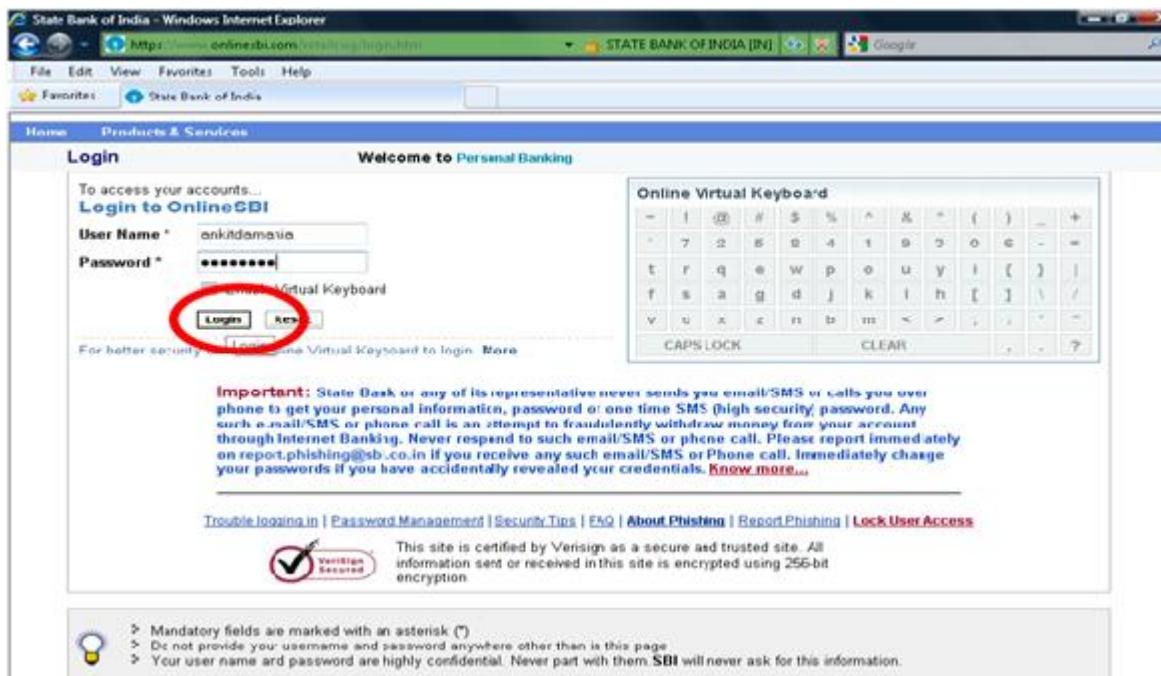


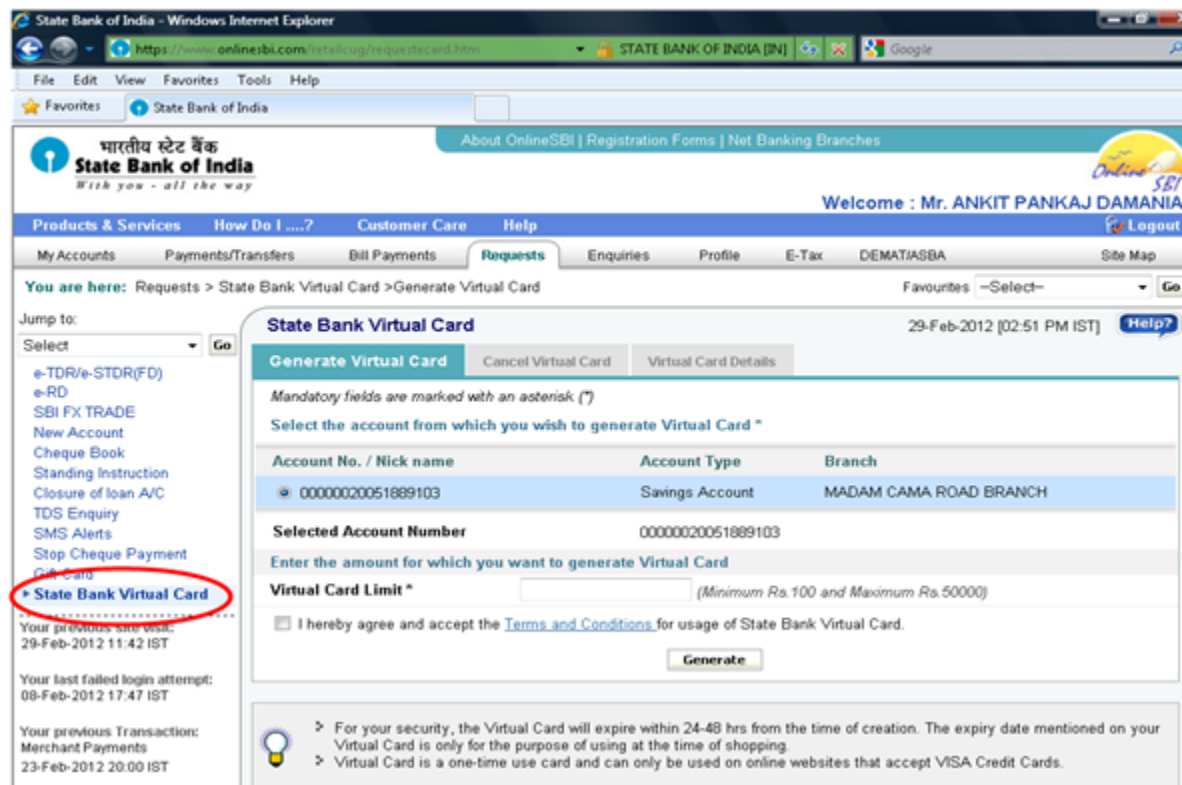
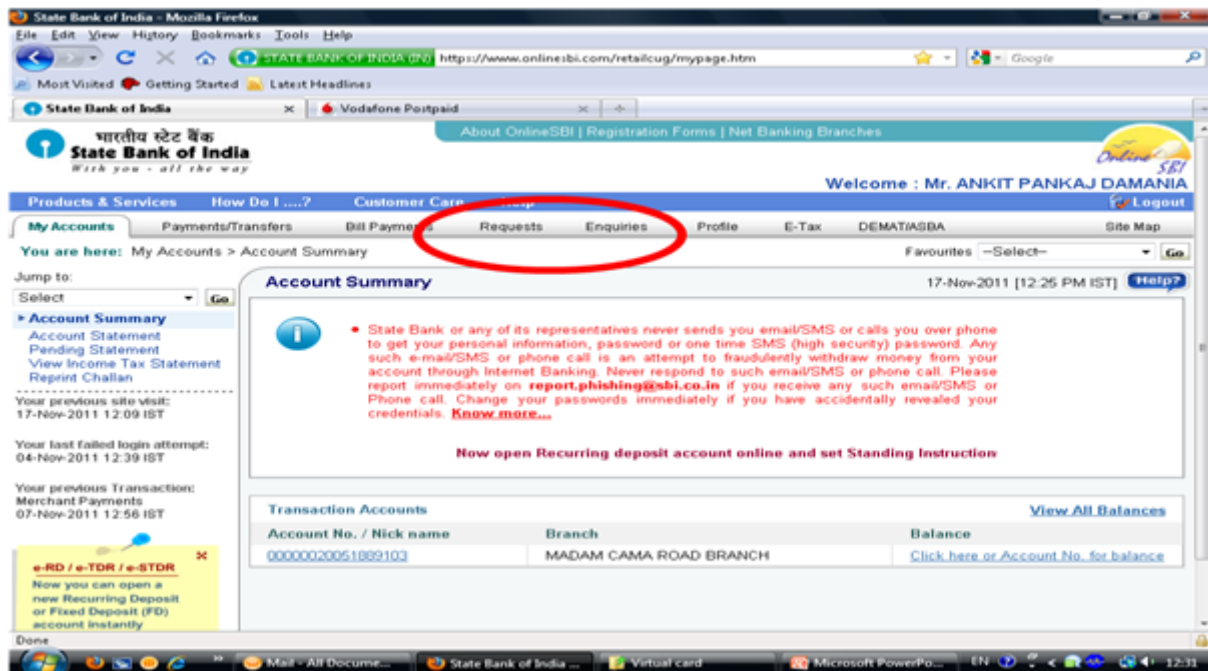
## Virtual Card Demo:

### I. Card Creation / generation:

Step 1. Login to your online banking account ([www.onlinesbi.com](http://www.onlinesbi.com))



Step 2. Click on “**Requests**” tab and select “**State Bank Virtual Card**” option.


## II. View Card Details

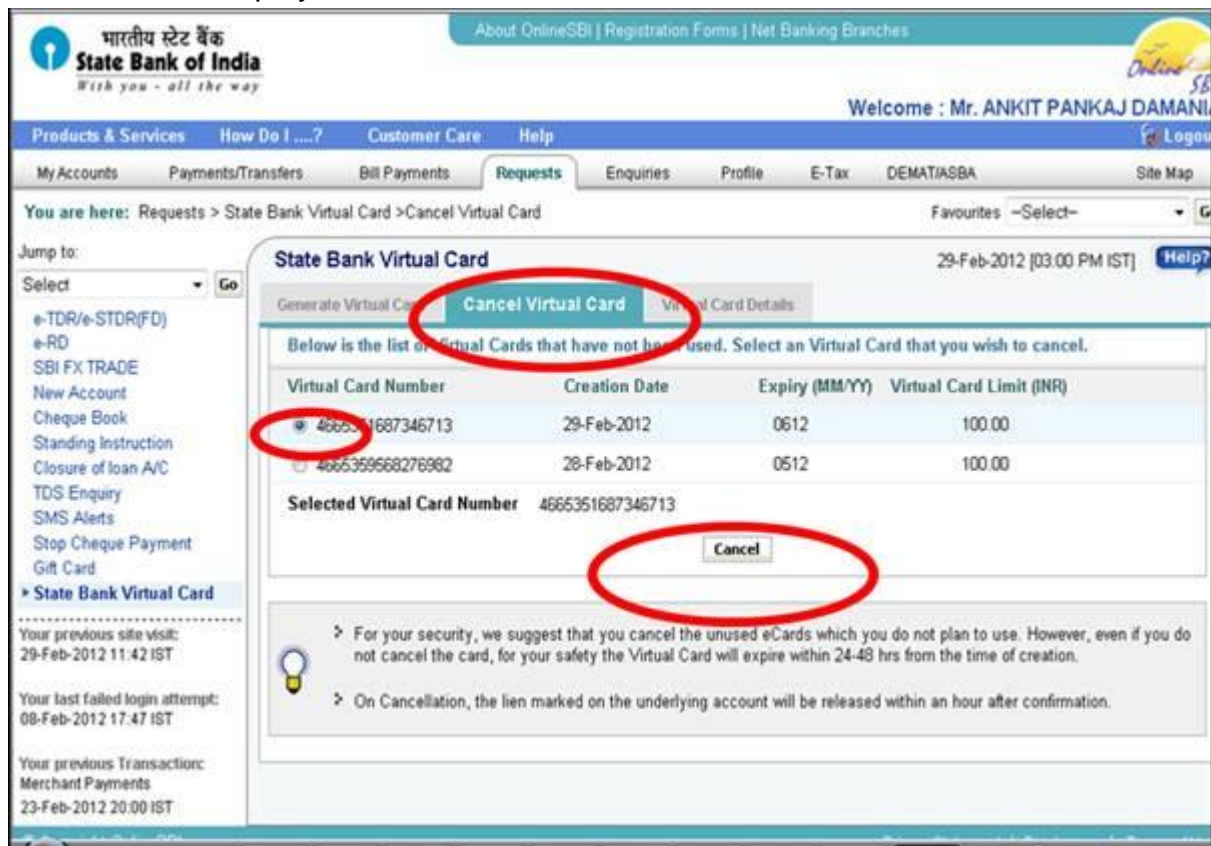
### III. View Card Details

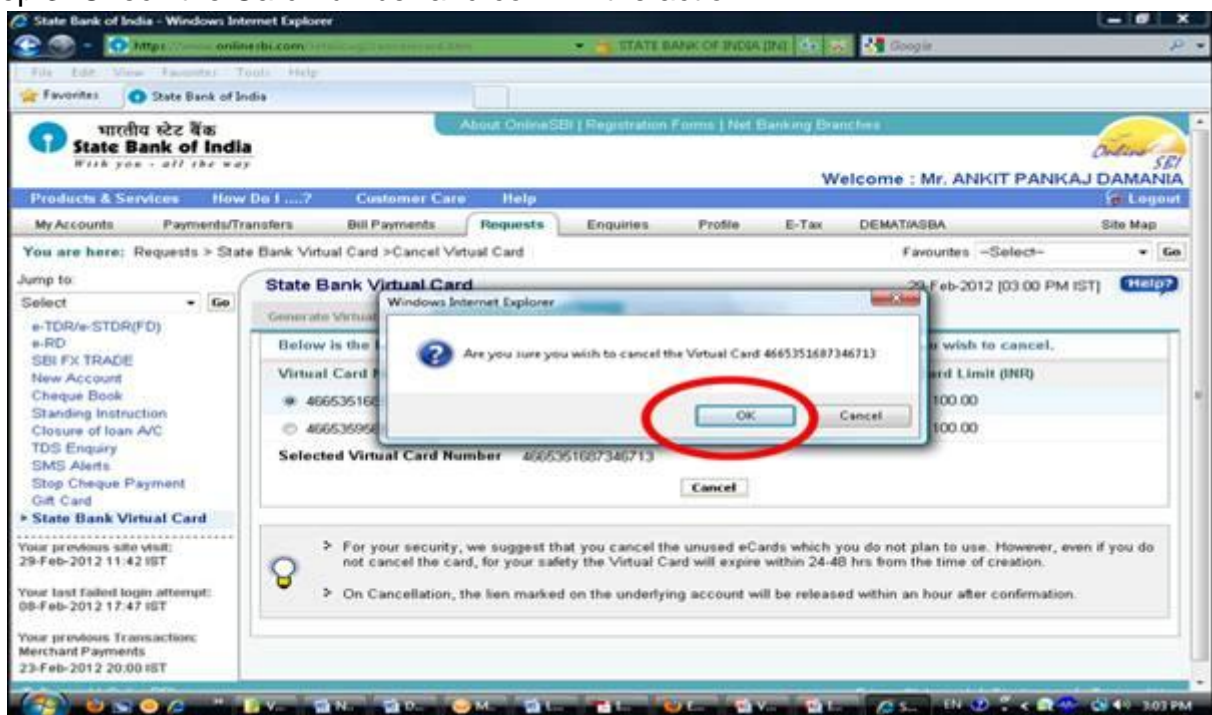




Step 2. Click on “**Cancel Virtual Card**” tab. A List of Cards that are available for cancellation is displayed to the customer.
